Our Boys' Varsity Basketball team is currently 14-8 and ended up 10-6 in the Tri-Valley Conference Hocking Division. The team won the Sectional Championship for the second year in a row, which is the first back to back Sectional titles in school history. The team advanced to the District Tournament.

Our Girls' Varsity Basketball team finished with a record of 13-10 and was 7-8 in the Tri-Valley Conference Hocking Division. The team won the girls' first Sectional Championship since 2006.

Other team highlights were that the Boys' 8th Grade Basketball team went 10-7, including a 6 game winning streak late in the season and the Boys' Reserve Basketball team had 7 wins.

Outstanding individual accomplishments from the winter sports season were that we had 2 high school boys' varsity basketball players reach the 1,000 point mark for their careers. Congratulations go out to Seattle Compston and Carson Starlin for achieving that feat.
